Cross Of Many Squares Quilt

Make your own Design Wall on Hobbs Heirloom Batting (70"x90" minimum)

Fold, press and mark Vertical Center Line with FriXion heat erasable Highlighter Marker.

Measure down 31" from top center, make Permanent Sharpie Mark for center of Cross, and mark the Horizontal Line for the cross beam of the Cross.

Using a 5"x24" rotary ruler, mark **generous 5" spacings** (leave a little Wiggle Room) use wide width of marker, see the entire width of previous line before placing the ruler again... creating a little extra space for re-arranging the fabric squares.

Each 5"x5" big square will hold four squares of fabric (2.5" each)

Five marks up from the center cross point at generous 5" spaces, and one mark at 2.5" to top of quilt.

Ten marks down from the center cross point at generous 5" spaces, and one mark at 2.5" to bottom of quilt.

Six marks out left & right from the center of cross point at generous 5" spaces to edge of quilt.

Extend all the vertical lines from top to bottom.

Extend all the horizontal lines from side to side.

I used ceramic tile floor grout lines to help me stay straight and square.

NOW COUNT and mark INDIVIDUAL 2.5" LITTLE SQUARES
The top of Cross will be Five Squares up from center cross point.

The bottom of Cross will be Fourteen Squares down from the center cross point.

The edges of Cross will be Six Squares out left and right.

See photo... Mark outline of Cross... center your 5' ruler on center horizontal line, marking at 2.5" parallel on each side of the center lines to the edges of Cross.

The Main Cross will have two rows of 2.5" squares across, and two columns of 2.5" squares down.

The Dark Outline of Cross will be one round of 2.5" squares (Cross is now 4 rows, 4 columns).

The Light Outline of Cross will be one round of White and/or lightest shades of Swooshes of colors.

The rest of the background will be divided into Swooshes of Colors ...see photo.

Liturgical colors for the seasons of the church: Green, Red, Purple, Blue, Gold.

Each color section should have light, med, and dark tones.
